CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Commissioner Thompson made the motion to approve the minutes of December 3, 2012 as presented. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION – ATKINSON SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

Engineer Marcus Jones stated on November 7, 2011, the Board of Commissioners approved the commitment of \$600,000 towards the Hendersonville Utility project now called Shepherd Creek / Atkinson Elementary Sanitary Sewer Improvements. The onsite septic system for Atkinson is experiencing costly repairs and is at the end of its life. This project will serve Atkinson Elementary with a pump station and associated forcemain which will tie into the Shepherd Creek gravity sewer. The \$600,000 is the cost associated with Atkinson's pump station and forcemain. The City will own and maintain the pump station and forcemain after completion.

A recent update from Lee Smith, Utility Director indicates that the project design is near completion. The attached budget amendment positions the County to provide the \$600,000 for its portion of the project's construction.

Auditors have reviewed and approved the transfer of funds.

Commissioner Hawkins made the motion that the Board adopts the budget amendment to provide funding for Atkinson Elementary School's sewer service. All voted in favor and the motion carried.
