Duties and Responsibilities: Performs intermediate technical and professional work involving the coordination of natural resource needs within Henderson County with government programs designed to meet those resource needs; position assigned to the County's Soil & Water Conservation District Office; Prepares contracts engineering surveys, engineering designs and permit applications for cost shared practices; provides site layout, supervises construction, and provides final inspection of cost shared practices; contacts landowners and provides information on easements, buffers, stream bank stabilization, cost share, conservation practices, and other relative information. Performs related duties as required. Work is performed under general supervision. Overall administrative supervision will be the responsibility of the Henderson County Soil and Water Conservation District. Immediate administrative supervision will be the responsibility of the District Director.

Qualifications: Thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of engineering as related to the preparation of plans and specifications for conservation practices; thorough knowledge general needs of urban and rural water quality concerns and solutions, including construction inspection, water quality indicators, and assessments; thorough knowledge of agriculture practices common to Henderson County; soil and water conservation best management practice application; thorough knowledge of CAD software, surveying and field data collection; general knowledge of principles and practices of budgeting; general knowledge of local, state and federal conservation rules and regulations and ability to work effectively with diverse government programs and agencies; ability to develop resource management plans on private lands; ability to clearly and effectively communicate orally and in writing with individuals and groups of citizens, understand public attitudes, and positively influence the public and individuals; ability to collect data, prepare and maintain files, schedules, and records, develop and present reports; ability to safely and efficiently operate a motor vehicle; ability to attend work regularly; excellent interpersonal skills.

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in civil, environmental, or agricultural engineering or related field and extensive years of experience working in civil, environmental, or agricultural engineering or equivalent combination of education and experience. Professional Engineering licensure preferred. Engineering Interns will be considered based on education and experience.

Pre-employment drug screen required.
