9th Avenue Road Closure Effective January 1, 2018

Hendersonville, NC – December 28, 2017

Effective January 1, 2018, 9th Avenue in Hendersonville closes for through traffic and will no longer be a public street. The 9th Avenue access off North Church (25 N.) will be barricaded beginning Tuesday, January 2, 2018. NCDOT will be adjusting the signal timing at the intersection historically know as five-points. The County will restripe the old 9th Avenue corridor to allow for temporary Hendersonville High School parking accessible off Oakland Avenue. Citizens should be cautious and aware of their surroundings as traffic adjusts to this change.

This road closure marks the beginning of construction on the new Hendersonville High School scheduled to begin fall of 2018 with demolition of the Boyd Property beginning February of 2018 through mid-March.
