Henderson County Solid Waste Recycling User Survey Available March 1-May 31

Hendersonville, NC – March 1, 2017

The Henderson County Solid Waste and Environmental Programs Divisions have just released a recycling user survey for citizens of the county to participate in from March 1 until May 31, 2017. The 13-question survey, mostly directed at Convenience Center users, also asks curbside recycling customers for their opinions. Access the survey online through www.hcrecycles.org. Staff will periodically be taking responses from customers at the Convenience Center.

“This survey is a great way for the County, as a service provider, to better understand recycling user participation in current and future waste diversion programs. We’re interested to know how people use our recycling offerings so we can evaluate program improvements and address community needs,” says Rachel Kipar, the County’s Environmental Programs Coordinator. The County will use the data to create and improve outreach efforts for recycling and solid waste users across the community.

The Solid Waste Department is considering making collection changes to the current operations at the Convenience Center. One item under consideration by the Solid Waste Department is a pilot collection program for organics. Curbside recycling customers will have the option to participate in the organics collection at the center. Once the Henderson County Board of Commissioners passes the FY18 budget later this summer, more details of these changes will become available.
