Synopsis of Events:

On Thursday September 11, 2008, the Henderson County Sheriff's Office with the assistance of the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation and the Hendersonville Police Department executed a search warrant at 318 Jody Street in East Flat Rock, N.C. This is the residence of a Harvey Franklin Hunt Sr. age 53 and Dorothy Louise Hunt age 29. Officers located approximately 65 dosage units of Crack/Cocaine, 172 grams of Marijuana, 23 dosage units of Oxycodone, 3 dosage units of Morphine, 2 dosage units of Hydrocodone, and 17 dosage units of Xanax in the residence as a result of the search. Both Harvey Hunt Sr. and Dorothy Hunt were taken into custody and charged with the above listed drug violations.

Sheriff Rick Davis stated "That this multi agency operation was the result of information received from the public and subsequent investigations by the agencies involved. We will continue to join forces and share intelligence in order to maximize our resources and effectiveness in dealing with this sort of problem. It is our intention to make people who sell and provide illegal drugs think twice before locating in Henderson County.
