

The Henderson County Sheriffs Office and the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation are conducting an investigation into the death of a Henderson County woman. The Sheriffs Office received a call at 0628 indicating that Charity Worley, 28 years of age, had been injured in an accident involving her own vehicle in the driveway of 1004 W. Gilbert Street in East Flat Rock. First responders arrived at the scene and found the victim in the driveway in close proximity to her vehicle, a Toyota SUV. The victim was transported to Pardee Hospital where she succumbed to her injuries.

At 0651 the first responders requested deputies to respond to the scene. Deputies arrived at 0657 hours and determined that further investigation would be necessary to determine the cause of death. Investigators from the Sheriffs Criminal Investigations Division assisted by the NCSBI are currently treating the matter as suspicious and unusual.
