

The Henderson County Sheriffs Office responded to 80 Minnehaha Drive at approx 2125 hours on the 7<sup>th</sup> of Jan. to a report of a stabbing involving several persons. Upon their arrival, deputies found Richard Gene Prince, 47 years of age at the residence. There was blood in the area, indication of a struggle, and Mr. Prince reporting that he had been attacked by two other individuals. Prince was suffering from apparent stab wounds and was transported to Mission Hospital via air ambulance where he was treated and released.

Further investigation by the Criminal Investigations unit revealed that another person was slightly injured as well. Toni Sue Prince 40 years of age, the wife of Richard was injured as well. She was treated and released from St. Josephs Hospital for minor wounds as well.

Detectives were able to determine that a domestic altercation had taken place between the husband and wife, resulting in an attempted intervention by another party. As a result of information gleaned through evidence and interviews, Richard Prince was arrested booked into the Henderson County Detention Center upon his release from the hospital. He was charged with Assault by Strangulation, Assault on a female, and Interfering with Emergency Communication. He was placed under a 500.00 dollar secured bond.

Sheriff Davis notes that "While the investigation is still ongoing, we do not anticipate further charges against other individuals at this time."
