

Deputies of the Henderson County Sheriffs' Office arrested Sara Philipscheck when she and a possible accomplice, James Kenneth Davidson Jr., were found in the area of a breaking and entering and larceny on Morgan road in Etowah.

Detective Galloway of the Sheriffs Criminal Investigations Division received a call of a possible Breaking and Entering in progress and of a suspicious white van located near 250 Morgan Road. Detectives had been looking for a vehicle matching that description during the course of other B&E investigations. Galloway and other patrol deputies responded to the scene to investigate. Upon the Detectives arrival both suspects attempted to flee the area. Philipscheck was apprehended at the scene and Davidson managed to flee on foot. Henderson County deputies assisted by a K-9 unit from Transylvania County Sheriffs Office, managed to set up a containment perimeter and eventually found Davidson in the area where he had fled to the home of a relative. At the time he was located, Davidson claimed to be in need of medical attention and requested medical treatment. He was transported to the hospital where he was receiving medical attention at the time of this press release. Deputies say that there was no struggle or altercation and there was no discernable reason for Davidson to require medical assistance, but it was provided as requested. "We will always err on the side of caution in a situation such as this." Davidsons only resistance was in fleeing deputies on foot. Deputies expect to question Davidson once he is medically cleared by the hospital.

Sara Philipscheck was arrested for Breaking and Entering and Larceny and was released on a \$500.00 promise to appear. Davidson has not yet been charged pending his release and further investigation by the Sheriffs Office.
