

Henderson County Sheriff's Detectives arrested three men for the break-ins and the larceny of various items at Jackson Park.

On Friday, March 6th 2009 the Henderson County Sheriff's Office responded to Jackson Park where park officials reported the breaking into the concession stand and two storage buildings where each had obvious visible forcible entry to each.

Two radar guns, three catchers' mitts, three dozen baseballs, two air horns and other miscellaneous items were taken from the buildings. The suspect(s) left each building with excessive damage where an axe was used to gain entry.

On Thursday, March 12th 2009 Detectives Scott Galloway and Cpl. Breana Williams arrested DERRICK LEE COX, 18 years of age of Cauble Road in Brevard for the crimes that had previously occurred. Cox was arrested and charged with Breaking and Entering and larceny after breaking and entering. Each charge is a felony count and was booked in the Henderson County Detention Center under \$ 1,000.00 bond.

On Friday, March 13th 2009 Detectives arrested DANIEL GLENN SMITH, 20 years of age and ALLEN ROY STOCKMAN, 18 years of age, each of Williamson Creek Road in Pisgah Forest additionally for the crimes that occurred in Jackson Park. Both Smith and Stockman were booked into the Henderson County Detention Center under a \$ 1,000.00 bond.

No other suspects remain at large in this incident.
