

Sheriff Rick Davis confirmed today, the arrest of Demetrius Cardero Slydell, of 21 Pleasant Court, for Felony Conspiracy to Commit 2nd Degree Burglary. The arrest comes as the result of information obtained by investigators concerning a burglary that took place at the residence of Ronald Rudisill at 2798 Howard Gap Road on April 10th 2009. Investigators believe that the burglary at Rudisills' residence took place just prior to a home invasion that occurred on the same property at 2822 Howard Gap Road and which resulted in the murder of Oscar Lee "Poochie" Corn.

Three other men were charged in the actual burglary that occurred at the Rudisill home as well as other charges including first degree murder that took place at the Corn residence. The three are still being held in the Henderson County Detention Center.

Demetrius Slydell, 22 years of age was arrested last night for having conspired with the perpetrators of the crime of 2nd degree burglary, although he is not believed to have been a direct participant in the burglary or the subsequent murder of Mr. Corn at Mr. Corns' residence.

Conspiracy may be charged in cases where a participant has taken place in planning or otherwise helping to facilitate a crime, even if that person was not present during the actual commission of the crime. Any further information regarding this case will be reserved for presentation in court in the appropriate time and venue.

Mr. Slydell is currently being held and is under a \$15000.00 secured bond.
