

BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT.

Attached our pictures of a suspect wanted for 3 recent bank robberies in South Carolina. Most recently this subject robbed the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina on Friday June 19, 2009 at approximately 11:10 a.m. (PICTURE 2). Two weeks ago on Friday May 29, 2009, he robbed Wachovia Bank in Forest Acres (outside of Columbia, SC) at approximately 11:46 a.m. (PICTURE 1). And two weeks prior to that on Friday May 15, 2009 at approximately 11:25 a.m. he robbed the United Services Credit Union in Fletcher, North Carolina (PICTURE 2).

Individual has robbed each bank at gunpoint using a small black semi-automatic handgun. He is described as a white male, approximately 6 feet tall with low - medium length dark hair and a goatee, weighing around 200 pounds. His arms are heavily tattoo'd. Suspect is believed to utilize a white Ford Truck, possibly an F-250.

Important: This individual has shown a pattern of robbing banks every other Friday in early afternoon.
