

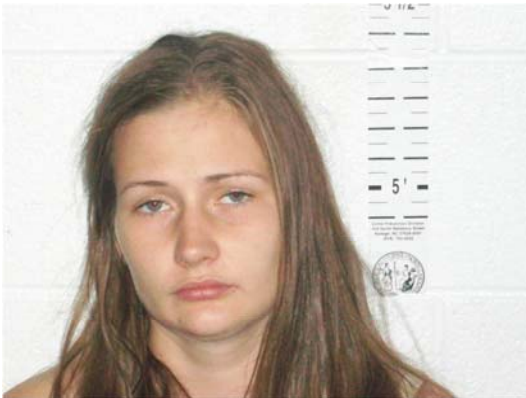
Detectives of the Henderson County Sheriffs Office Violent Crimes Unit have taken warrants on three individuals involved in an early morning home invasion of a residence located at 149 Haven Rd in the East Flat Rock area of Henderson County.

Deputies received the call shortly before 1:00 a.m. this morning (July 7, 2009) reporting that a burglary and assault had taken place at 149 Haven Rd. Responding officers found that the occupants of the residence, Wanda Eleen Gilliam, 51 years of age and Randall Douglas Gilliam, 49 years of age, reporting that they had been awakened from sleep and assaulted in their home. Both victims showed signs of bruising, abrasions and other trauma typical of assaults. Mr. Gilliam was transported by EMS for medical treatment. Mrs. Gilliam also required some medical treatment, however both were treated and released.

The victims reported that the suspects took various pharmaceutical medications from their home after assaulting them with a metal flashlight and an air rifle. Officers stated that the investigation is still ongoing with some suspects still being interviewed at the time of this press release. Investigators are not looking for any others at this time however the investigation is still in its early stages. No further information is available at this time.

Charges on the suspects are as follows:

Amber Renee Nelson- W/F -DOB 10/12/1987-of 203 Shorty Collins Lane, Hendersonville, 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Conspiracy to commit 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Assault with a deadly weapon, and Felony larceny. She is in the Henderson County Detention Center under a \$50,000 bond.



Eric Anthony Jones-B/M-DOB 04/20/1983- of 324 James Street, East Flat Rock, 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Conspiracy to commit 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Assault and battery, and Felony larceny.



Justin Devon Scott-W/M- DOB 07/14/1984- of 640 King Road, Hendersonville. 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Conspiracy to commit 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Assault with a deadly weapon with the intent to kill, and felony larceny.
