

Henderson County Sheriffs' deputies responded to 2303 Rolf Street at approx. 10:22 p.m. last night to investigate a report of a knife assault. When officers arrived, they found two men identified as Kyle Dillon Jeeter, 26 years of age and Cody Talsky age unknown, on the porch of the residence. Mr. Jeeter appeared to have been stabbed in the back and Mr. Talsky, a friend, was holding a towel to the wound.

Both men told officers that a third man who had fled the area, had stabbed Jeeter during a fight that had taken place between the two men. Investigators from the Violent Crime Unit responded to further process the scene and conduct interviews. Mr. Jeeter was transported to Pardee Hospital, and later transferred to Mission in Asheville.

Investigators are continuing to follow leads this morning. The name of a suspect has not yet been released but investigators expect to take warrants soon and will release that information when the identity and charges are certain. No further info at this time.

Two men have been arrested as the result of an investigation into a stabbing incident that took place on Rolf Street this past Tuesday evening the 28th of July. Michael David McHenry 23 years of age was charged with Assault with a Deadly Weapon in an assault on Kyle Dillon Jeeter. Mr. Jeeter 26 years of age was also charged by investigators for Resist, Obstruct and Delay as a result of lying to officers during the investigation into the stabbing in which he was the victim. Investigators determined that Mr. Jeeter, was less than forthright with information regarding the case and cost officers extra time and follow up hours trying to determine all the facts of the incident.

Further investigations revealed that the incident which took place that evening stemmed from an illicit drug deal that went badly. Investigators will not release further details however are content that no other persons were directly involved. The charges brought against the two men are simply those that could be determined at this time based on the facts and evidence available.

Mr. Jeeter was also arrested on two outstanding warrants for Resisting a Public Officer, and Driving While License Revoked that were issued as a result of an earlier and unrelated incident.
