

## 1<sup>st</sup> INCIDENT at DEERFIELD'S

A stabbing that occurred last night within moments of another unrelated stabbing across the county is still being investigated at this time. At 0232 hours, the Sheriff's E911 office received a call for medical assistance for a wound to the neck that occurred at the Deerfield's property at the end of South Mills River Road in Mills River. The area is a venue for various concerts and festivals. The victim is Reggie Ray Rhodes of Groveland Illinois. Subsequent investigation revealed that the victim had been assaulted with a broken beer bottle and suffered a deep laceration. He was transported to Mission Hospital for treatment of his wound. Investigators say that they expect Rhodes to be released from the hospital later today. Investigators also said that charges are unlikely at this time due to the victims' unwillingness to pursue charges against the perpetrator of what could have been a deadly assault.

In addition to the fact that the victim admitted to using LSD and Ecstasy, he was also said to have been assaultive toward others at the festival. He was not very forthcoming with information that could help further the investigation. The fact that the victim admitted to using illegal drugs comes as no surprise to the investigators who have been called to the area before in response to assaults and widespread drug use in the event area.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> INCIDENT at DEERFIELD'S

Sheriff's Office arrested Gary Scott  
Grether in the area of Deerfield's located  
at 101 Watagnee Trails, Mills River NC.**

**According to a Drug Enforcement Agent for the Sheriffs' Office, Mr. Grether had approached two individuals and offered to sell them "chocolate mushrooms". These mushrooms are usually a schedule I class hallucinogen from the psilocybin class of mushroom and are, of course, illegal. During the course of their investigation, officers confiscated the following drugs from Mr. Grether.**

**1: Three clear in color plastic baggies containing approximately 9.7 grams of Marijuana (Schedule VI)**

**2: Fourteen " Chocolate Mushrooms " approximately 420 grams. ( Schedule I)**

**3: Approximately four " hits " of LSD. (Schedule I)**

**4: Digital Scale. (paraphernalia)**

..Mr. Grether was placed under arrest and transported to the Henderson County Detention Facility. He was charged as follows:
