

Sheriff Rick Davis confirmed the capture of Henry Wayne Hollenbeck and his wife Cathy Regina Hollenbeck who abducted their 10 month old daughter Arizona Hollenbeck from the State of North Carolina. Investigators suspected that the couple may have fled to Wyoming. Detective and SBI agents have been working around the clock since receiving the report of a possible abduction from the Henderson County Dept of Social Services who has legal custody of the child.

"I am very grateful for this outcome. This was some truly superb detective work on the part of our Criminal Investigations Division, and as always, the North Carolina SBI pulled out all the stops to assist us from this end. We are also pleased with the prompt and professional service we received from the Cheyenne Wyoming Police Depart who took the Hollenbeck's into custody. They were able to put our minds at ease regarding the health and welfare of the baby, Arizona. Our team was very impressed with their enthusiastic response to our request for assistance."

At this point there is no further information to release. The abduction of the minor child is an extraditable offence and if the Hollenbeck's refuse to waive the extradition process we certainly will initiate the process from here.
