

A Henderson County man was shot at his residence on Big Hungry Road in Henderson County. At 9:57p.m. Friday night, deputies were dispatched to a residence located in the Upward community to reports that a man had been shot. Upon their arrival to the scene they found a male individual who appeared to have been shot, and another man with him who was requesting medical assistance for the injured man. Officers also quickly located a female suspect across the street from where the shooting had taken place. She was taken into custody without incident and is currently being interviewed by Investigators from the Sheriffs' Criminal Investigations Division Violent Crimes Unit.

The shooting victim was transported to an area hospital and his condition is unknown at this time. It is expected that the investigative process, including crime scene processing and interviews will last into the morning hours. At this time we can not release any further information due to the ongoing nature of the investigation and pending notification of family members.

As charges are filed and arrests are made, I will send you that information as up to date as I have it.

UPDATE

Last night just before 10:00 p.m. the Henderson County Sheriffs Office responded to a report of a shooting at 940 Big Hungry Road in the Upward community. When Deputies arrived on the scene they found the owner of the residence at the scene, bleeding profusely from an apparent gunshot wound to the chest. Another individual was assisting the victim.

Both individuals indicated to deputies that the suspect, a female named Beverly Williamson Lominac, 41 years old, had left the scene and gone across the road to another residence. As officers secured the area and Henderson County Emergency Medical Service attended the victim, other deputies went to look for the suspect. She was found nearby and taken into custody. Lominac offered no resistance.

The victim, James Donald Sizemore, was transported to an area hospital and was still alive at this report. No further information is available regarding his condition.

Investigators believe that Lominac and the victim are related as cousins, and that she had been staying at the residence as a guest. According to witnesses, a dispute erupted and Lominac shot Sizemore in the chest with a .45 cal. semi automatic pistol. She then fled the scene. Investigators indicate that there was evidence of illegal drug use at the scene and witness statements also corroborate that information.

Beverly Williamson Lominac was arrested and charged with Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill, Inflicting Serious Injury. She was placed into the Henderson County Detention Center under a \$50,000.00 secured bond.

911 recordings are not available at this time. We will release it after required redaction of non public information; most likely on Mon.
