Please label everything with your child's name!!!! We do have a lost & found area. We will ask your child to check the lost & found items during check-out. We cannot be responsible for lost items, so please remind your child that they are responsible for keeping up with their belongings. Please do not send any money, expensive or irreplaceable items. No electronic or video games are allowed. No cell phones please!

If you are unable financially to provide some items your camper needs, please contact Sgt. Nock for assistance.

Dare Camp will be held at "All-Star Retreats" which is located at Camp Pinewood in Hendersonville. Directions to the camp are at the end of this information. **You will need to drop off your camper at 8:00 AM the first day of camp. Pick-up will be at 8:00 PM on the last day. Please be prepared for a substantial wait in line for drop off and pickup.**

Some of the possible activities are: songs, speakers, games, K-9 demonstrations, fishing, swimming, canoeing, crafts, archery, first aide, "the blob", zip line, campfire, tons of water activities, a lot of good eating and more! (Our theme will be "Survivor" with chore immunity challenges!) **An optional short devotion will be held daily. Please let your camper know if you want them to participate in the devotion.** Those not attending devotions will have alternate activities.

There is absolutely NO COST to the camper for DARE Camp. All you need to do is provide transportation to camp and pack their necessities. Breakfast, lunch, supper and snacks will be provided each day. Employees of the Sheriff's Office, volunteers and college and high school counselors provide supervision of campers.

We have a registered nurse on staff and other medical assistance is available in case of any emergencies. If your child has a medical situation, a disability or nutritional needs that we need to be aware of, please call Sgt. Nock before DARE Camp to discuss their situation. If there is medication to be given at camp, you will need to bring the medication to the nurse on the first morning of camp, sign a release and give us permission to give the medication. (If your child has asthma and uses inhalers, please make sure you bring them to camp. Also if a nebulizer is used, even rarely, please bring it and the necessary medicines to go with it.) If there are activity restrictions due to medical reasons, please speak personally to our nurse during drop-off.

Please be sure that your camper is dressed comfortably for camp with tennis shoes available. Your child should NOT bring any money, toys, cell phones, electronic games, or expensive items to camp. Please do not allow your child to bring any food or keep any medications such as Tylenol in the cabins. Medications (even over the counter drugs) must be stored by the nurse for safety. **Please label clothes and all items brought to camp with your child's name!** This will enable us to return lost and found items at camp. **We cannot be responsible for any items lost at camp.**
